**- Environmental Resource Science Articulation -**

The purpose of this Joint Institutional Agreement is to formally establish an educational partnership between the two institutions, and specifically, between the departments that administer Environmental Resource Science courses and degrees. Furthermore, this agreement is intended to provide greater access to higher educational opportunities for traditional and non-traditional students in the field of Environmental Resource Science.


All policies and procedures of the Board of Regents (BOR) of the University System of Georgia (USG), the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), the University of Georgia (UGA), and Gordon College will be applicable to this agreement.

Students who earn the Associates of Science Degree from Gordon College by completing the list of courses presented below with a minimum Regents grade point average of 2.8 will be offered transfer admission into the Environmental Resource Science major, College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, The University of Georgia. Prospective transfer students with a 2.5 – 2.8 transfer grade point average may be considered for admission on a case by case basis subject to space availability. Strong consideration will be given to students who have completed or are in progress of completing the intended courses listed below. All students are encouraged to consult with an academic counselor from both institutions as early as possible to plan course work that will best meet their individual educational goals.

This agreement is valid starting with the date of signature of both Presidents and remains in effect until terminated in writing by either institution.


